- Health inequities in California
- Health is determined primarily by social determinants of health:
 - Living conditions—physical, social, economic, and services. (e.g., income/jobs, housing, transportation, discrimination, decision-making power).
- Main causes of death in California are from chronic diseases, which can be mitigated by climate strategies that prioritize physical activity and healthy food.
- All climate change policies will have some impact on these social determinants of health, and represent a significant opportunity to improve population health and health inequities.







2. Lung cancer	5.6%
3. Cerebrovascular disease	4.6%
4. COPD	4.0%
5. Alzheimer disease	3.9%
6. Self-harm	3.8%
7. Road injuries	3.8%
8. Drug use disorders	3.2%
9. Colorectal cancer	3.0%
10. Diabetes	2.5%

8 out of 10 deaths in California are due to chronic diseases like heart disease, stroke, cancer, type 2 diabetes, obesity and chronic respiratory ailments.




