## **Regulatory Notice**

The California Air Resources Board (CARB) is providing this notice to ensure regulated entities are aware of key compliance deadlines related to control periods for the sale, supply, or transport of California Reformulated Gasoline (CaRFG).

CaRFG regulations limit, among other properties, the Reid Vapor Pressure (RVP) of gasoline sold, offered for sale, supplied, offered for supply, or transported within the state ([title 13, California Code of Regulations, section 2262](#)). In order to control evaporative emissions of hydrocarbons, the RVP of summertime gasoline is generally restricted to a production or importation limit of about 7.0 psi. The RVP restrictions apply to gasoline throughout the distribution system, including retail sales. These summertime RVP limits go into effect for gasoline sales in California, depending on the air basin, according to the regulatory control periods specified in section 2262.4 of the CaRFG regulation.
