### **Subpart U-Standards of Performance for the Phosphate Fertilizer Industry: Superphosphoric Acid Plants**

## Applicability and designation of affected facility - §60.210

Source	All Emissions
General	<ol> <li>Superphosphoric acid plant having a design capacity of more than 15 tons of equivalent P2O5 feed per calendar day. For the purpose of this subpart, the affected facility includes any combination of: evaporators, hot wells, acid sumps, and cooling tanks, and</li> <li>Facilities commence construction or modification after October 22, 1974.</li> </ol>

#### Standard for fluorides - §60.212

Source	All Emissions
General	No facility shall cause to be discharged into the atmosphere any gases which contain total fluorides in excess of 5.0 g/metric ton of equivalent P2O5 feed (0.010 lb/ton).

#### Monitoring of operations - §60.213

Source	All Emissions
General	<ol> <li>Facility shall install, calibrate, maintain, and operate a flow monitoring device determine the mass flow of phosphorus-bearing feed material to the process. The flow monitoring device shall have an accuracy of ±5 percent over its operating range.</li> <li>Facility shall maintain a daily record of equivalent P2O5 feed by first determining the total mass rate in metric ton/hr of phosphorus- bearing feed using a flow monitoring device meeting the requirements of paragraph (a) of this section and then by proceeding according to \$60.214(b)(3).</li> <li>Facility shall install, calibrate, maintain, and operate a monitoring device which continuously measures and permanently records the total pressure drop across the process scrubbing system. The monitoring device shall have an accuracy of ±5 percent over its operating range.</li> </ol>

# Test methods and procedures - §60.214

Source	All Emissions
General	<ol> <li>In conducting the performance tests required in §60.8, the owner or operator shall use as reference methods and procedures the test methods in appendix A of this part or other methods and procedures as specified in this section, except as provided in §60.8(b).</li> <li>The owner or operator shall determine compliance with the total fluorides standard in §60.212 as stated in §60.214(b).</li> </ol>
