CARB SB 1383 Efforts

- Approved final version of <u>Short-Lived Climate</u>
 <u>Pollutant Reduction Strategy</u> in March 2017
- Released a draft <u>Guidance on Environmental Credits</u> generated under the Low Carbon Fuel Standard and the Cap-and-Trade Program.
- Workshopped a draft <u>Pilot Financial Mechanism</u> to enhance the certainty of the value of environmental credits for dairy projects producing low-carbon fuel.
- Released <u>Policies to Encourage Dairy Biomethane</u> <u>Projects and Other Projects to Reduce Methane</u> <u>Emissions</u>

CARB SB 1383 Efforts (cont'd)

- CARB and UC Berkeley are planning to co-host a
 Bioeconomy Summit in Spring 2018 to consider
 strategies for organic diversion and utilization.
- CARB continues to assist and support sister agencies in their SB 1383-related efforts:
 - CEC 2017 Integrated Energy Policy Report
 - > CPUC Dairy Biomethane Pilot Projects Rulemaking
 - CDFA <u>Alternative Manure Management Program</u> and <u>Dairy Digester Research & Development</u> <u>Program</u>

Dairy and Livestock Working Group Efforts

- CARB (with sister agencies) provides support in:
 - Organizing Dairy and Livestock Working Group and subgroup meetings
 - Corresponding with subgroup members and invited speakers.
 - Posting and updating information on group webpages
 - Analyzing and providing feedback on relevant studies, data, and other information
- Additionally, each subgroup meeting has CARB representation for regulatory and policy assistance;
 - Floyd Vergara (Industrial Strategies Division Chief)
 - Mary Jane Coombs (Project Assessment Branch Chief)

Dairy and Livestock Working Group Efforts (cont'd)

- Michael FitzGibbon (CARB Research Division's Climate, Atmospheric Science, & Economic Studies Branch Chief) added as a third co-chair on Subgroup #3, utilizing CARB's research resources.
- A new section created under the Industrial Strategies
 Division will be managed by Mike Ginty to consolidate
 and focus CARB's dairy policymaking efforts.

Next Steps

- CARB staff will continue to offer support to the Dairy and Livestock Working Group and subgroups through the end of 2018 when final recommendations are presented.
- CARB staff will continue to support sister agency-led programs.
