4. What is the naming convention for OBD2 approval letters and EPA Certificate of Compliance (EPA CofC)?

OBD2 Letters

OBD2_E_CY_XXX_MM_DD_YYYY.pdf

Where:

OBD2 = On-Board Diagnostic 2

E = E series letter assigned to OBD2 group

CY = 2 digit calendar year the letter was written

approval letter

This number is taken

directly from the OBD2

XXX = Letter number assigned by OBD2 group

MM_DD_YYYY- 2 digit month, 2 digit day and 4 digit year letter was signed.

Example:

OBD2_E_06_067_03_15_2006.pdf

EPA Certificate of Compliance

Once the manufacturer receives an EPA certificate, the manufacturer should scan it; upload the scanned file into the engine-family/test-group folder using the following file naming convention.

CC_XXXXXXXXXXXX_CERT#_MM_DD_YYYYY.pdf

Where:

CC = EPA certificate of conformity

XXXXXXXXXXX = 12 digit engine family name

CERT# = EPA Certificate number

MM_DD_YYYY = Date when the CofC was signed or revised

Example:

CC_6KTXC.942LC8_40T221_04_13_2006.pdf
