#### **Program Status and Achievements**

- Program status:
  - \$190M allocated to-date including \$75M in Fiscal Year (FY) 21-22
  - Funded more than 12,000 vehicle replacement projects
  - All district programs are currently open
  - San Diego's program is coming soon.
- Program Updates:
  - Statewide expansion
  - Enhanced flexibilities
  - Assembly Bill (AB) 630 Report Goals and Program Evaluation











### **Developments for Statewide Expansion**

- Clean Cars 4 All (CC4A) Public Meetings
  - August 2021
  - January 2022
- FY 21-22 Funding Plan Approval
- Guideline Changes to Enable Expansion
  - Completed by June 2022
- FY 22-23 Draft Budget Bill Zero-Emission Vehicle (ZEV) Package
  - \$250 million proposed allocation



### **Goals of Program Expansion**

- Expand equitable access to clean transportation
- Maintain the community-focused outreach, education, and consumer protections
- Respond to stakeholder support for expansion beyond 5 largest air districts
- Continuation of existing district programs



### **Proposed Eligibility**

- Residents in every zip code not currently eligible for CC4A
- Income requirements
  - < 300% Federal Poverty Level</li>
  - \$65,880 for a household of three
  - \$79,500 for a household of four
  - Nearly 90 percent of program participants meet this criteria
- Maintain focus on communities with greatest need



# **Equity Strategies**

- Needs-based approach
  - Lowest incomes, disadvantaged communities
- Work with Community-Based Organizations and Access Clean California
  - Targeted outreach, education and access
- Utilize improved survey data
- Stakeholder and Community Input
  - What other factors should determine need?



#### Solicitation for Statewide Administrator

- Proposed joint solicitation with Clean Vehicle Assistance Program
  - Maximize partnerships for targeted outreach and support for communities with the greatest need.
  - Streamlining various CARB incentive programs for the consumer
- Open to entities with experience in administering equityfocused incentive programs



#### **Solicitation Timeline**

- To be released early June 2022
- To close early July 2022
- Applicant Selection Period
- Applicant summaries
  - Published 10 days prior to announcing the solicitation award



#### Teleconferences

- Preliminary teleconference to be hosted mid-June 2022
- Final teleconference to be hosted late-June 2022
- Only solicitation related questions will be answered
- All Q&A documents to be published on webpages



### **Applicant Selection Period**

 Questions will be only be addressed during the teleconferences

- Email is preferred
- Selection period will be about 3-5 weeks



# **Evaluation and Goal Setting Report**

- Developed as part of the Funding Plan process
- Mandated by AB 630 to analyze performance and set quantifiable goals
- Illustrates long-term direction of CC4A
- Informs other long-term plans such as the Three-Year plan for ZEV Incentives



# **Evaluation and Goal Setting Report**

- Participant feedback and stakeholder input is essential
- Incorporates past experiences and lessons learned
- Other data includes:
  - Completed projects
  - Application volume and processing capacity
  - Department of Motor Vehicles data and other metrics
- Report development meetings in following weeks
