Thank you for submitting the Terminal Plan (Plan) on behalf of the Amports Facility at the Benecia Port Terminal to the California Air Resources Board (CARB) as required by the Control Measure for Ocean-Going Vessels At Berth (“Regulation”). CARB staff has reviewed your Plan submittal and has determined that it fulfills the requirements of the Regulation as set forth in section 93130.14(a). CARB considers your Plan complete, and no changes are necessary at this time.

Updated Terminal Plans are due by February 1, 2024, as set forth in section 93130.14(a)(2)(F), and can be submitted to CARB at [shorepower@arb.ca.gov](mailto:shorepower@arb.ca.gov). These updated Plans must reflect any changes since the initial Plan. Once received, CARB will have 90 calendar days to review updated plan submissions for any deficiencies.
