Dear Morgan,

Thank you for submitting the Port Plan for the Port of Long Beach. We wanted to let you know that CARB staff have identified a number of deficiencies with Plans submitted by multiple terminals at the Port of Long Beach (predominately tanker terminals). We will be sending individual letters to each terminal operator, with the Port in cc, to advise them of the Plan deficiencies and requesting they submit a revised plan. Because the Port's plan relies heavily on information provided by the terminal plans, we would like to request that the Port work with the terminals to revise the Port & Terminal Plans and resubmit to CARB. We expect to have those letters sent out in the next few weeks.

If you have any questions at this point or after receiving the letters, please let us know. We are happy to schedule follow up calls as needed.
