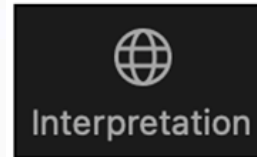

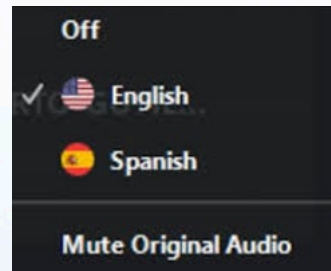
Accessing Zoom from a computer

Zero-Emission Truck Loan Pilot

- Currently available
- Uses a loan loss reserve system
- Fleets contact an eligible lender
- Eligibility:
 - On-road ZEVs class 2b & up
 - Fleets up to 20
 - Contribution rate is set at 25%

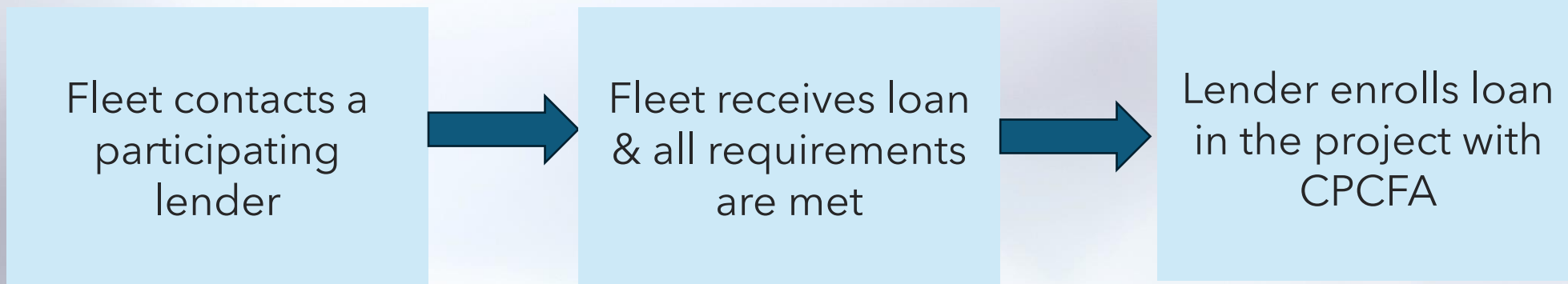
