



Zero-Emission Truck Loan Pilot Project Introduction

Zero-Emission Truck Loan Pilot

- Currently available
- Uses a loan loss reserve system
- Fleets contact an eligible lender
- Eligibility:
 - On-road ZEVs class 2b & up
 - Fleets up to 20
 - Contribution rate is set at 25%

Status:

Opened May 1, 2024 \$5 million from Fiscal Year 2022-23 \$4 million from legacy project





Zero-Emission Truck Loan Pilot

- Administrator: California Pollution Control Financing Authority
- Partners: CA Energy Commission
 & Southern California Edison

Draft Staff Proposal:

\$5 million allocation for Fiscal Year 2024-25

No policy changes recommended

Borrower Application Process:

Fleet contacts a participating lender



Fleet receives loan & all requirements are met



Lender enrolls loan in the project with CPCFA
