**Chevron Richmond Refinery
CARB At-Berth Regulation: IC.4 Retraction**

Dear Ms. Soriano:

Following discussion with the California Air Resource Board (CARB) on June 3, 2024, Chevron Richmond Refinery is retracting Project 4: IC.4 FCC Ammonia Optimization from its CARB At-Berth Innovative Concept Application submitted on December 1, 2021. As of February 2024 from the BAAQMD Regulation 6 Rule 5 settlement, the proposed IC.4 would no longer achieve emissions reductions that exceed any reductions otherwise required by a legally binding mandate, as required by California Code of Regulations title 17, section 93130.17(a)(6).
