Dear Mr. Sran,

As requested in your February 10, 2026 email correspondence, the California Air Resources Board (CARB) has revised the stationary engine family list for the DCL International Inc. (DCL) Mine-X Sootfilter® diesel particulate filter verification and issued the attached Executive Order (EO) DE-08-002-08.

Of the 111 engine families DCL requested, 105 met all the EO criteria and were added to the engine family list. Six engine families were not included in the revision: two that were already included in the July 23, 2025 update, and four that exceed the verification particulate matter limit of 0.15 grams per brake horsepower hour.
