The Department of Finance, in consultation with California Air Resources Board and other State agencies (Administration), is required to submit a three-year Investment Plan to the Legislature to guide the investments of Cap-and-Trade Auction Proceeds, referred to as California Climate Investments. These investments help California achieve its greenhouse gas reduction goals, while realizing additional health, economic, and environmental benefits.

The Draft Investment Plan will be posted prior to the workshops at <https://ww2.arb.ca.gov/resources/documents/cci-investment-plan>. In each location, representatives from the Administration will provide an overview of current investments, introduce the preliminary recommendations presented in the Draft Investment Plan, and respond to questions from the public. The Administration will present the same material at both workshops. Background

The State proceeds from the Cap-and-Trade Program (title 17, California Code of Regulations, section 95800 et seq.) provide an opportunity for California to invest in programs and projects that further the objectives of Assembly Bill 32 through California Climate Investments. This statewide initiative puts billions of Cap-and-Trade dollars to work reducing greenhouse gas emissions, strengthening the economy, and improving public health and the environment—particularly in disadvantaged communities, low-income communities, and low-income households.
