

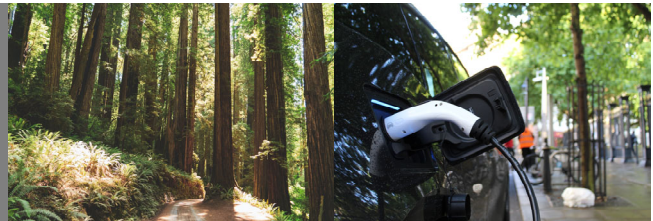

You are invited to provide input on the Draft Cap-and-Trade Auction Proceeds Fourth Investment Plan for Fiscal Years 2022-23 through 2024-25 (Fourth Investment Plan). The Department of Finance, in consultation with California Air Resources Board and other State agencies, is required to submit a three-year Investment Plan to the Legislature to guide the investments of Cap-and-Trade auction proceeds.
