










Priority Populations




Cumulative Investments (as of May 2020)

Fourth Investment Plan







- High-level recommendations for priority investments
- Fourth Plan: Due to the Legislature in January
 2022, covers Fiscal Years 2022-23 through 2024-25
- Legislature and Governor determine appropriations through annual budget process

 Recommend sectors and project types to prioritize for investment




