# **Regional Transportation Planning and Programming**

- Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) and Regional Transportation
   Planning Agencies (RTPAs) are required by law to prepare Regional Transportation
   Plans every 4-5 years
  - Regional Transportation Plans describe a region's transportation vision and goals and include a fiscally constrained project list

# **Regional Transportation Plan Guidelines**


- Identify the federal and state requirements and statutes impacting the development of Regional Transportation Plans
- Facilitate the efficient development and implementation of transportation projects
- Promote an integrated, statewide, multimodal planning process
- Provide resources, tools, and examples


### **Comments Received to Date**

  Act Housing Coordination Plan
- Federal Performance Management
  Requirements
- Sustainable Communities Strategies:
  Updated Information and Resources





## **Key Changes Affecting MPO + RTPA Versions**

- No new requirements for RTPAs
- Updated language for key policy areas:
  - Equity and environmental justice
  - Climate adaptation resources
  - Vehicle miles traveled analysis under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)
