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# 2022 Data Reporting Recap

- 832 reports submitted
- 493 verified
- 100% received positive / qualified positive emissions verification statements
- Other reports not subject to verification (i.e., abbreviated reporters or retail providers with no imports/exports)

# Key Reporting Dates for 2023 Data

Date	Activity	
April 10	Regulatory Deadline: Reports due for facilities and suppliers of fuels and carbon dioxide, except when subject to abbreviated reporting	
June 3	Regulatory Deadline: Reports due for electric power entities and those subject to abbreviated reporting	
August 12	Regulatory Deadline: Verification statements due (emissions data and product data)	

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### Reporting and Verification Schedule

- RY2023 is the third year of the compliance period
- Site visits optional unless you hire a new verifier or had a qualified positive verification statement last year
- Verification statements due by Aug. 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024
- No extensions to reporting or verification deadlines
- Failure to submit a report or verification by the required deadline is a violation of the regulation for each day the report or verification is late

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### Enforcement

- Issues that could lead to enforcement
- Incorrect data reported
- Failure to fix correctable errors that result in an adverse statement
- Late reports or failure to report
- Late verification or failure to verify
- CARB has completed enforcement actions related to reporting

- If you think you may be eligible for cessation of reporting or verification [pursuant to section 95101(h)] or are ceasing operations [section 95101(i)], contact CARB staff before the reporting deadline so we can ensure regulatory requirements are appropriately met

- Save and file any CARB responses as part of your GHG Monitoring Plan and provide to your verifier

# General Reporting and Verification Information

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#### Verification Essentials

- New verification body is required every six years
- · Be prepared to trace data to its origin
- Ensure GHG Monitoring Plan meets the requirements of section 95105(c) and includes any additional information that would be helpful to your verifier
- Correctable errors must be fixed. If not, verifier must submit an adverse statement
- If verifier or reporter is unsure of requirements, please contact CARB for
- Retain written/emailed guidance from CARB staff for review by your verifier

### Verification Best Practices


- Initiate verification as soon as possible to allow time for revisions
- Streamline verification:
- Execute verifier contract prior to report certification
- Associate your report with your verifier at any time
- Provide data to verifiers ASAP
- It is good practice to have a webinar prior to a site visit (if required)
- Be ready for questions early in the process from your verifier
- If no site visit is conducted, we highly recommend a webinar with screenshare
- Communicate promptly to ensure important issues are discussed early
- Start early and plan to finish early to ensure timely submittal

### Reporting Reminders

- Don't forget to submit and certify a generated report
- If your report won't generate:
- Clear all validation messages
- Clear a pending Certificate of Representation (COR)
- As the DR (Designated Representative), notify CARB if you will no longer serve as the
- It's the company's responsibility to notify CARB and re-assign someone as the DR
- We've had issues tracking down new personnel when the DR leaves, therefore, we highly recommend all reporters designate an ADR (Alternate Designated Representative)
- · Late reporting violations do apply in such cases
- Notify CARB promptly if your facility is being sold or operational control changes
- CARB will evaluate responsibility for reporting, verification, and C&T compliance
- Can be complicated if transfer occurs during verification

# Certifying and Submitting a Report


Ensure your annual emissions data report is "certified" in Cal e-GGRT



SUBMIT and CERTIFY REPORT If you have reviewed and are satisfied witl your Annual Report you may pre includes applying your electronic signature (entering your password and an After clicking the SUBMIT/CERTIFY button, and completing the certification p via Calle-GGRT. You will not be able to generate a new report until the certifie Requested by a verifier or CARB staff.

### Clearing Validation Messages

Example: For electricity generating facilities, total facility electricity generation, and nameplate capacity in Subpart A must equal the sum of unit-level electricity generation and nameplate capacity in Subpart C



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## Clearing a Pending COR

- When a new DR/ADR accepts their invitation, a Certificate of Representation (COR) must be signed
- An incomplete COR appears under Home tab of invitee's account
- Report cannot be certified and submitted with a pending COR



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### CARB Quality Assurance (QA)

#### Process:

- CARB staff complete QA checks on reported data
- Send outreach to reporters and/or verifiers if potential errors are identified via direct email, phone call, or finding reports
- 1. Spring/Summer Outreach = Reactive
- 2. First Quarter Outreach = Proactive

## CARB QA Outreach: Finding Reports

 Entity report is uploaded into the Cal e-GGRT entity account  User report is uploaded into the Cal e-GGRT user account



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### Lessons Learned

### Units Combusting Natural Gas

• Amount of fuel purchased in Subpart A (in MMBtu)



• Match closely with sum of unit-level inputs in Subpart C (or D)



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
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### Units Reporting Thermal Energy

- Thermal energy disposition in Subpart A needs to match closely with total thermal output in Subpart C
- Keep in mind: total thermal output should roughly equal how much steam you use + how much steam you sell



## Method Change Requests

- Section 95103(m) of MRR provides requirements for:
- Temporary or permanent changes to prescribed methods
- Alternative measurement and monitoring methods
- Contact CARB if a method change is needed
- Submit requests as soon as possible to facilitate approval in timely manner



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
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# Electric Power Entities (EPE) Guidance Spotlight

### New: Steps to Enable Workbooks


- Windows security update requires downloaded workbooks to be "unblocked" and "enabled"
- Follow these steps:
  - After downloading the file, right-click the file and select Properties.
  - At the bottom of the Properties window, under Attributes, check the box that says "Unblock." (see screenshot)



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### New: Steps to Enable Workbooks



- 3. After performing steps 1 and 2, open the file.
- 4. Click the "Enable Content" button in the yellow bar at the top of the spreadsheet, under the Excel
- 5. Save the file after clicking "Enable Content."

### Energy Storage Systems (ESS) Import Reporting

- ESSs (such as batteries) are to be treated similarly to transmission hubs on the physical path for RY2023 & RY2024
- No ESS losses or lesser of analysis are required
- RY2023 guidance and EPE workbooks will be updated and posted in March
- Any EPE needing to report ESS imports in RY2023 should contact CARB

## Biogenic Emissions for Hydrogen Production (Subpart P)

Subpart P now allows biogenic emissions to be

reported

 Fuel/Feedstock categories went from 6 choices to 18 choices for both <u>exempt</u> and <u>non-exempt</u> biogenic emissions

 The choice of fuel type in this pull-down will then dictate covered emissions when you upload your XML file for fuel and feedstocks

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# Blend Fuels for Biogenic Emissions (Subparts C, D, and H)


• Fuel type determines if emissions are covered vs exempt

• Blend Fuels now include both exempt and non-exempt

fuel types

 Several refineries will now more easily be able to report non-exempt biogenic emissions





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# More Options for Biogenic Emissions from CEMS

- Subpart H and P now allow non-exempt biogenic emissions to be reported for CO<sub>2</sub> CEMS
  - Available within Subparts C and D soon

ANNUAL CO2 EMISSIONS MEASURED BY	THE CEMS —
Total annual CO2 mass emissions	(metric tons)
Total annual exempt biogenic CO2 mass emissions	(metric tons)
Total annual non-biogenic CO2 mass emissions (includes fossil fuel, sorbent, and process CO2 emissions)	(metric tons)
Total annual non-exempt biogenic CO2 mass emissions (includes fossil fuel, sorbent, and process CO2 emissions)	(metric tons)

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### Reminder: Choosing a Verification Body

• Entities subject to verification can select a VB at any time



- Verifiers submit conflict of interest forms via Cal e-GGRT
- Approvals from CARB typically take less than a week
- $\bullet$  New reporters must select a VB before verifier can submit COI

### Greatest Risks for Mis-reporting

- New reporting entity staff
- Please keep DR/ADR info up to date so we can contact new staff
- If you need help, please <u>reach out!</u> That's what we're here for
- Assuming previous methods/reported data were correct
- Contact CARB staff to confirm your own understanding of basic reporting requirements

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### Cost of Implementation Fee Update

- CARB will send COI fee invoices electronically by upload to Cal e-GGRT (e.g., RY2022 accounts for this year), with email notification sent to DRs, ADRs, and the listed Responsible Party
- Please ensure your DR, ADR, and/or Responsible Party for Payment and Email has been updated
- We will not share invoices with parties who are not explicitly affiliated with your current account

The Suppliers of Transportation Fuel and NG Fuel Guidance document was updated in March 2023.

Probably not worth mentioning unless you want to highlight the change.
