## **Background**

Assembly Bill (AB) 617 was signed into law in July 2017. CARB established the Community Air Protection Program to implement AB 617, which requires new communityfocused action to reduce air pollution and improve public health in communities that experience disproportionate burdens from exposure to air pollutants. In February 2018, CARB staff released two documents to provide our initial concepts for the Program requirements and to get the public involved in building the Program: the "Community Air Protection Program Concept Paper" and the "Draft Process and Criteria for 2018 Community Selections."

In early June 2018, staff will release a more comprehensive document titled the "Community Air Protection Program Draft Blueprint" with detailed requirements for June 4, 2018 Page 2

Program implementation, which reflects comments we received on the initial documents and public input provided during outreach events. This Draft Blueprint will include: processes and criteria for identifying and selecting impacted communities; statewide strategies to reduce emissions of criteria air pollutants and toxic air contaminants; and requirements for the development of community air monitoring plans and community emissions reduction programs.
