Form 21 Instructions

Use this form only if the engine or equipment unit has an existing registration with the California Air Resources Board (CARB).

1. *Company Name* - Legal name on the existing registration.
 2. *Registration Number* – The number shown on the existing registration certificate and sticker.
 3. Describe equipment failure or attach documentation describing the failure. Identical replacement means it is the same manufacturer, type, manufacturer's maximum rated capacity or rated brake horsepower, is intended to perform the same or similar function as the original portable engine or equipment unit, and meets the emission requirements of title 17 Cal Code Regs., section 93116.3(c)(1) and sections 2455 through 2457 of the PERP Regulation. An identical replacement is appropriate only for cases of equipment failure of an engine or equipment unit.
 4. Fill out and attach **an engine registration form** for engines or **an equipment unit registration form** for equipment units. Submit the form with this form. Remove or destroy the sticker on the replaced unit.
- 5 -7. *Name, Title, Date, Signature, and Phone Number of Responsible Party* – The person signing and dating form.

Upon receipt of a completed application, we will provide you with an invoice for the fees due.

Please note that under the California Public Records Act (Gov. Code, § 6250 et seq.), your submissions, including associated contact information (e.g., your address, phone, email, etc.) become public records and may be released to the public upon request. Personal information will be protected from disclosure as required by law, including under the Information Protection Act. (Cal. Civ. Code, § 1798, et seq.) Information that is claimed to be confidential should be submitted as provided in CARB's regulations for submitting confidential data, California Code of Regulations, title 17, section 91011.
