- 1. Company Name Legal name of entity, business, organization, agency or private individual that operates the registered portable engine.
- 2. PERP Registration Number Enter the registration number from the registration certificate or sticker.
- 3. Company Unit ID Enter the Company Unit ID that can be cross referenced with the engine registration number.
- 4. Record Source Enter the method used to record engine operation as indicated in the Operating Conditions for the engine registration.
- 5. Location Enter the location using street address and city OR county and UTM coordinates OR other location indicator where the engine operated or was located on the date indicated. Location should be recorded no less than once a month.

- 9. Total Usage Enter the total hours or gallons of fuel for the day.
