Medium-Duty/Heavy-Duty Program

Proposed Program Design

- SDG&E provides infrastructure to support a minimum 3,000 medium-duty/heavy-duty vehicles
- California Public Utilities Commission proposed decision possible by 1^{st} quarter of 2019 \rightarrow SDG&E implementation could happen by 2^{nd} half of 2019
- SDG&E will introduce a new rate designed for non-residential EV use!
- Five year enrollment and implementation period if approved


