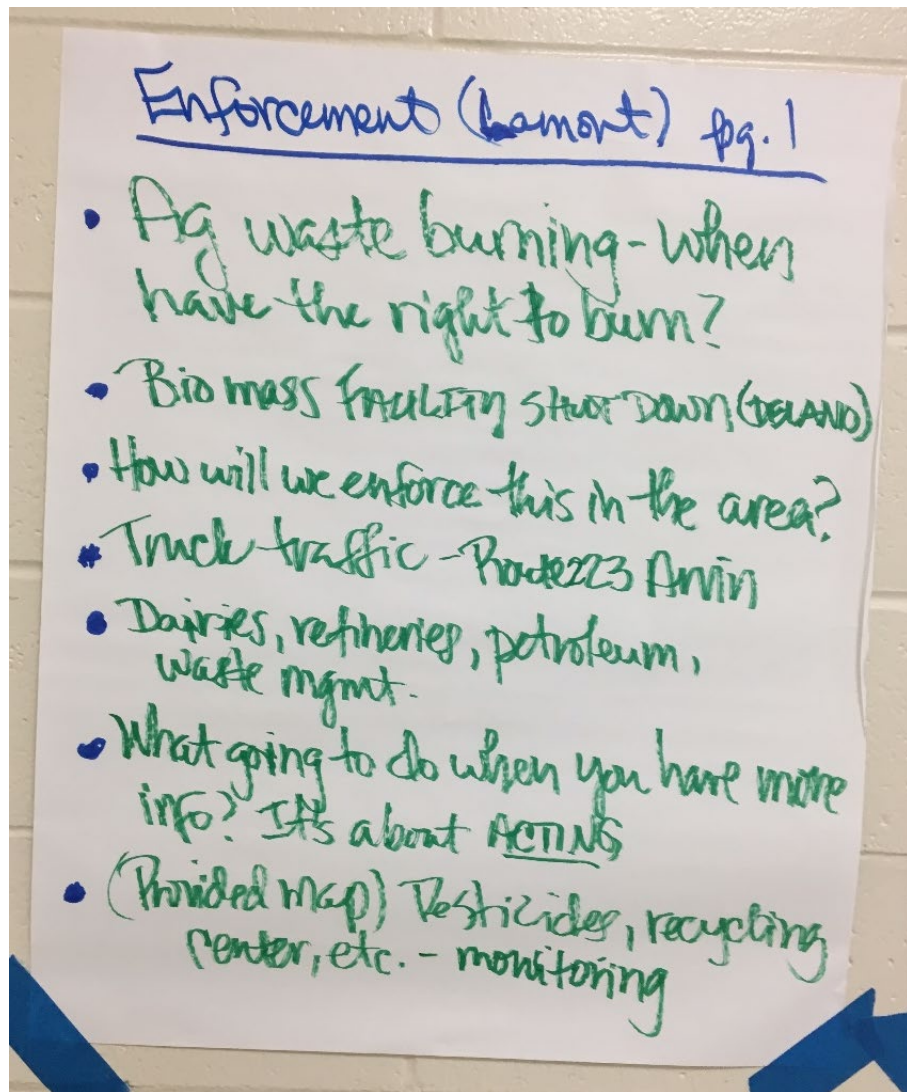

- NOT clear \$ is for all communities

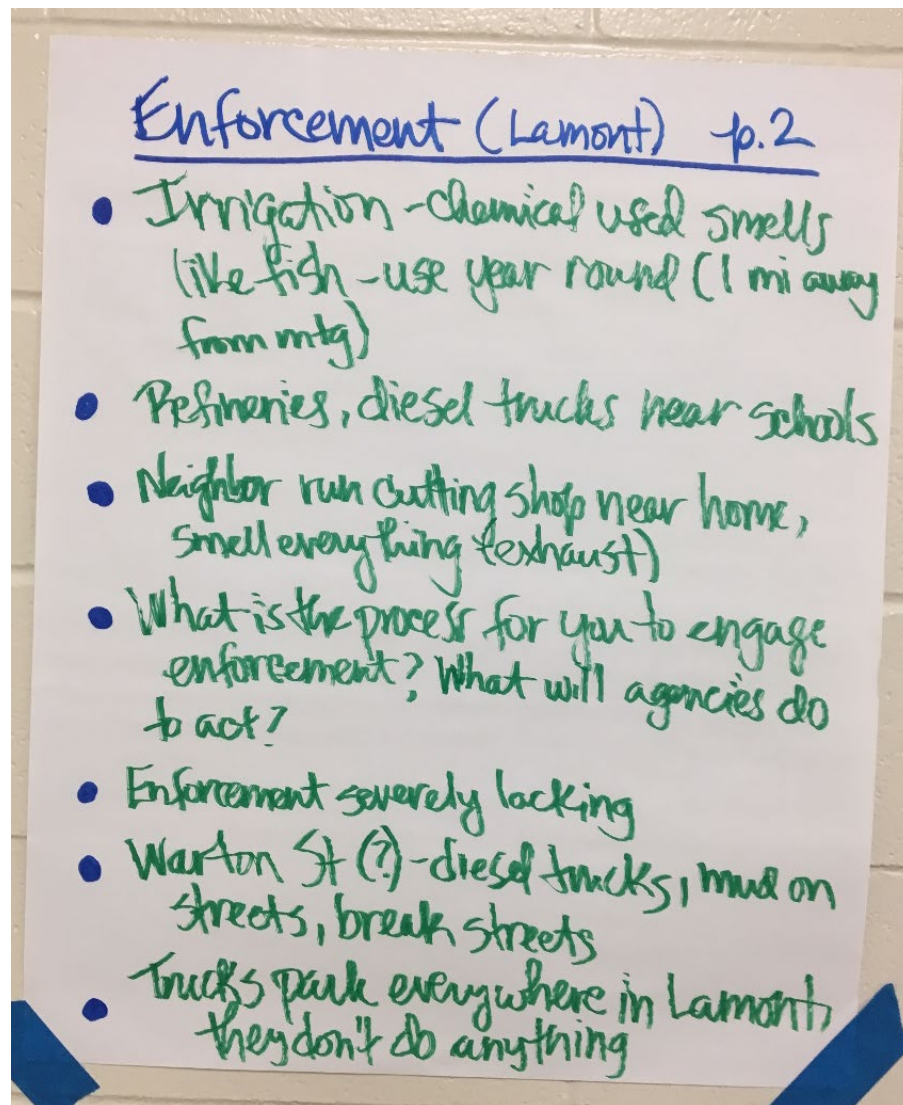

Feb 5, 2019 LAMONT, AB617 Incentives

Concerns

- truck traffic through Lamont
- oil refineries
- Rise in cases of asthma
- Produce-packing factories (including traffic from HWY 58 + HWY 99)
- traffic by schools
- incentives go to Ag + Oil Industries and NOT communities
- don't just relocate emissions - reduce them
- give incentives to small-business truck drivers
- SJV gives too much money to big businesses

AB 617 Incentives

Feb 5, 2019 LAMONT AB617 Incentives

- poverty line for mobile funding is too ~~high~~ low
- odors from dairy farms + refineries are bothersome
- digesters + monitoring would help
- incentives should not favor one technology over another eg. nat gas vs. electric
- incentives for cng engines for heavy duty trucks b/c electric is not available
- funding for air monitoring at schools including pesticides
- advertise better - through PSA's, newspaper, etc. mailers, radio
- there are other community concerns apart from air quality eg. sidewalks, clothing, nutrition etc.
