Enforcement 2/11/19 Stockton ①

Lathrop Rd X-town HDD Traffic (since expansion)

- Air Quality around schools
- Warehouses in Lathrop
- Truck routes → lack of enforcement
- Truck idling → Harland
- Fugitive dust → construction
- Farmland → rezoned residential/commercial
 - Pesticides
 - River Island
 - Close to school (LHS)
- Cement trucks along Lathrop
 - manufacture

Enforcement 2/11/19-Stockton ②

- Cross-town traffic. Stockton becoming bedroom community for Bay Area.
- Carpooling requirements/incentives
- Washington school South Fresh St.
 - Truck Traffic (South Stockton)
 - Idling
- Alternate truck route not working
- Water treatment plan
 - edge of port
 - odor complaints

 - Downwind of H₂O treatment facilities → Schools + Neighborhood.

AB 617 Incentives

1 - Stockton

Incentives

- Trees for Air Quality improvements + energy conservation
- Port emissions near schools (Diesel exhaust) (Diesel Trucks at ports)
- Truck traffic close to schools
- Odor from Navy Drive, near Washington School
- Control requirements can be burdensome for Owner/operators
- Children suffer from allergies
- What can community do to help achieve cleaner air
- how is the incentive money allocated? ✓
- \$ for electric cars for more citizens
- Public transit - light rail, buses, etc.

2 - Stockton

Incentives

- Public transit - bicycle infrastructure
- Air filters for homes

Vouchers for Nebulizers + inhalers

- incentives should be spent on ^{projects} priorities that are identified by communities + Community groups
