Complete this form in addition to Form 1 and either a Form 2 or a Form 3 if you would like to operate your portable engine while waiting for your registration. Incomplete and/or ineligible applications will be returned. You must submit a complete Form 6 and a photograph of the engine label at the time of the initial registration request in order to receive a temporary registration. By submitting this request, you are agreeing to complete the registration process, including payment of applicable fees.

NOTE: When you receive this form, stamped and signed below, it serves as your temporary registration document. Please keep it with your engine.

1. **Company Name** - Legal name of entity, business, organization, agency, or private individual that owns or operates the portable equipment.
2. **Mailing Address** - Address where the company or owner can be contacted.
3. **Company Information** - The email, phone, and fax numbers need to belong to the company, not a third party. Examples of third party members are consultants, distributors, sales representatives, lawyers, etc.
4. **Serial Number** – Engine Serial Number - A unique, unit specific number, usually on the engine nameplate or stamped into the engine block. For example: PE4045D123456.
5. **Engine Family Name** – If the engine is an EPA or CARB certified engine, please provide the 11 or 12 character engine family name. The engine family name will be on a tag or label with the heading “Important Engine Information” or “Emissions Information.”
6. **Printed Name of Responsible Party** - Responsible Party is the individual employed or otherwise retained by a company, public agency, or municipality that has the authority to certify that the portable equipment complies with all applicable requirements of the PERP regulation. This person must be a direct employee to the company, not a third party. Examples of third party members are consultants, distributors, sales representatives, lawyers, etc.
7. **Signature of Responsible Party with Date** - Signature of responsible official described above. (Application will not be accepted unless signed and dated.)

If this form is not filled out completely, or is missing a photograph of the engine label, we will return your application.

Please note that under the California Public Records Act (Gov. Code, § 6250 et seq.), your submissions, including associated contact information (e.g., your address, phone, email, etc.) become public records and may be released to the public upon request. Personal information will be protected from disclosure as required by law, including under the Information Protection Act. (Cal. Civ. Code, § 1798, et seq.) Information that is claimed to be confidential should be submitted as provided in CARB’s regulations for submitting confidential data, California Code of Regulations, title 17, section 91011.
