



Status of Air District Implementation of AB 617 Rule Updates

This requirement is intended to provide additional air pollution reduction benefits from certain types of sources by requiring air districts to review rules and provide for accelerated retrofit of pollution controls on industrial facilities.

- Applies to specific air pollutants from large industrial sources in 18 air districts
- By January 2019 districts completed their schedules for reviewing rules and implementing best available retrofit controls
- Implementation required by 2023
