### Common reasons why CARB did not select certain sites

- Technical and logistical limitations
  - Insufficient power supply
  - Lack of fencing/security
  - Limited site access during and outside of business hours
  - Difficult to transport equipment to/from site
  - Required additional security clearances
  - Size of trailer and monitoring equipment too large for site
  - Numerous physical obstructions and barriers on site property that could impact CARB staff's safety
- Location relative to the Inglewood Oil Field – site was neither in the predominate downwind or upwind direction of the oil field
- Inability to make contact via phone and email after several attempts
