Community Air Protection Program



Reduce cumulative criteria and toxic air pollutants


Communitydriven action

Focus on communities that experience disproportionate burdens from exposure to air pollutants.


Blueprint for Program Implementation

Defines statewide strategies and sets requirements for:

- Public engagement and community partnerships
- Selecting communities
- Conducting community air monitoring
- Developing community emissions reduction programs (CERP)
 - Including Enforcement Components



Community Emission Reduction Programs



CERP Enforcement Components

Enforcement Plan (*Blueprint, p. C-29*), which includes:

- 1. A three-year enforcement history;
- 2. Compliance goals;
- 3. Enforcement mechanisms; and
- 4. Community outreach.

Enforcement Strategies (*Blueprint, p. C-24*)

- <u>New actions</u> that will further reduce air pollution disparities beyond existing measures,
- Including enhanced enforcement that goes beyond existing efforts
- Include enforceable agreements to ensure rules and regs achieve reductions.

- Analyze and interpret data
- Communicate results to support action


Some Challenges
