These requests must also include hour meter readings that were taken at the beginning of that month. Include the date that the reading was taken. There are strict limitations for operation of engines designated as emergency-use or low-use. Review the Portable Diesel Engine ATCM to determine if your engine can comply with these limitations.

NOTE: If you installed a VDECS device such as a diesel particulate filter, the device must be one which has been verified by CARB and meets the terms and conditions in the CARB Executive Order. Enter the CARB Executive Order number and the VDECS family name from the label on the device. The modification applies only to retrofit devices, not to devices which are part of the engine as it is produced by the engine manufacturer.
