This form is designed to help OPOs, APDs, and holders of offset credits provide information as specified in section 95989.

- 2. Governmental reports from local, state, or national environmental, health, or energy agencies, or multinational bodies (such as the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change).
- 3. Monitoring or other analytical data.

A summary, including a list of all data, information, and reports, is requested. A summary may be provided in the space provided or may be separately attached. Attach all information supporting the application to this form when submitting to CARB.
