



ST. JOSEPH'S HOSPITAL Jerry Roek Memorial Garden Illustrative Plan














  - Include economically viable renewable energy sources in new buildings.


### **Energy Source**



#### **Greenhouse Gas Emissions**



•2.5 % decrease between FY 2011 and FY 2012 •16.1% cumulative decrease from FY 2008- FY 2012








### Renewable Energy Program

- Mercy Elk Grove was designed and constructed using energy efficient technologies that includes:
- •A 197kW solar array to offset approximately 35% of the electrical consumption
- Integrated into the parking canopies which also provides covered parking for approximately 80 automobiles
  - To date, system has produced 251K kWh
  - Reduced CO2 emissions by 180 tons
  - Saved over 20,000 gallons of gasoline

#### **Water Conservation**

- Implementing improved water reporting system beginning in FY
  2014
- Cumulative reduction in usage of 8.8% from FY 2008 through FY
  2012
- •St. Joseph's Hospital (Phoenix, AZ) installed 76 waterless urinals-reduced consumption by 1.8M gallons/yr.
- •Glendale Memorial Hospital and Health Center modernized their cooling towers-reduced 5.4M gallons/yr.
- Northridge Hospital Medical Center modernized their cooling towers-reduced 4.8M gallons/yr.
