SUBJECT: PUBLIC WORKSHOP TO DISCUSS PROPOSED REGULATORY
AMENDMENTS FOR RED STICKER OFF-HIGHWAY
RECREATIONAL VEHICLES

The California Air Resources Board (CARB) invites interested parties to participate in a public workshop on Wednesday, May 16, 2018, in El Monte, California, to discuss proposed regulatory amendments for Red Sticker off-highway recreational vehicles (OHRV). The purpose of this workshop is to present and solicit public feedback on a draft regulatory proposal that would phase out the current Red Sticker program and reduce emissions from OHRV in California. Staff will discuss the projected costs and benefits of the proposal, and will outline various alternatives for consideration.
