**NCUAQMD Annual Report for the AB 617 Grant
(Reporting Period from April 29, 2019 to April 29, 2020)**

The North Coast Unified Air Quality Management District (District) received a grant in the amount of \$22,659 in fiscal year 2018-2019 from the California Air Resources Board (CARB) to support the District's implementation of Assembly Bill (AB) 617. To meet the mandates set forth by AB 617, the District launched a new Community Air Protection Program (CAPP). This annual report describes the District's use of the grant funds to implement the District's CAPP efforts. Information in this report include: I) the grant information, II) cost associated with specific tasks, III) a list of the District's accomplishments and how they are consistent with the goals of AB 617, IV) activities completed and in progress, V) remaining and expended grant funds, and VI) an expenditure summary.
