MANAGEMENT

The Bay Area Air Quality Management District (Air District) is writing to express its strong support for the California Air Resources Board's (ARB) petition requesting the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) exercise its authority to develop and promulgate more stringent emission standards for locomotives.

DISTRICT

The Air District was created by the California Legislature in 1955, as the first regional agency to combat air pollution in California. The Air District's jurisdiction includes the nine county San Francisco Bay Area, home to approximately seven million people and over 100 municipalities. The Air District regulates approximately 20,000 stationary sources of air pollution in this jurisdiction and is governed by a twenty-four-member Board of Directors, consisting of elected officials, including county supervisors, mayors, and city council members.

> The Air District had previously writtten to you on March 15, 2017, requesting USEPA consider accelerating current standards to reduce toxic diesel particulate matter emissions from locomotives operating in the West Oakland and Richmond, California communities, and along San Francisco Bay Area's rail corridors. The Air District believes that its request, in concert with the development of Tier 5 locomotive standards requested by ARB, would be protective of air quality and public health in these communities. The Air District would therefore encourage USEPA to consider these requests in tandem and to move forward on rulemaking to further reduce locomotive emissions as expeditiously as possible.

The Air District is making this request in light of the fact that it believes technologies

to significantly reduce emissions from line-haul, switch, long-haul, and passenger

can be accelerated. The current deployment of higher emitting locomotives in the
