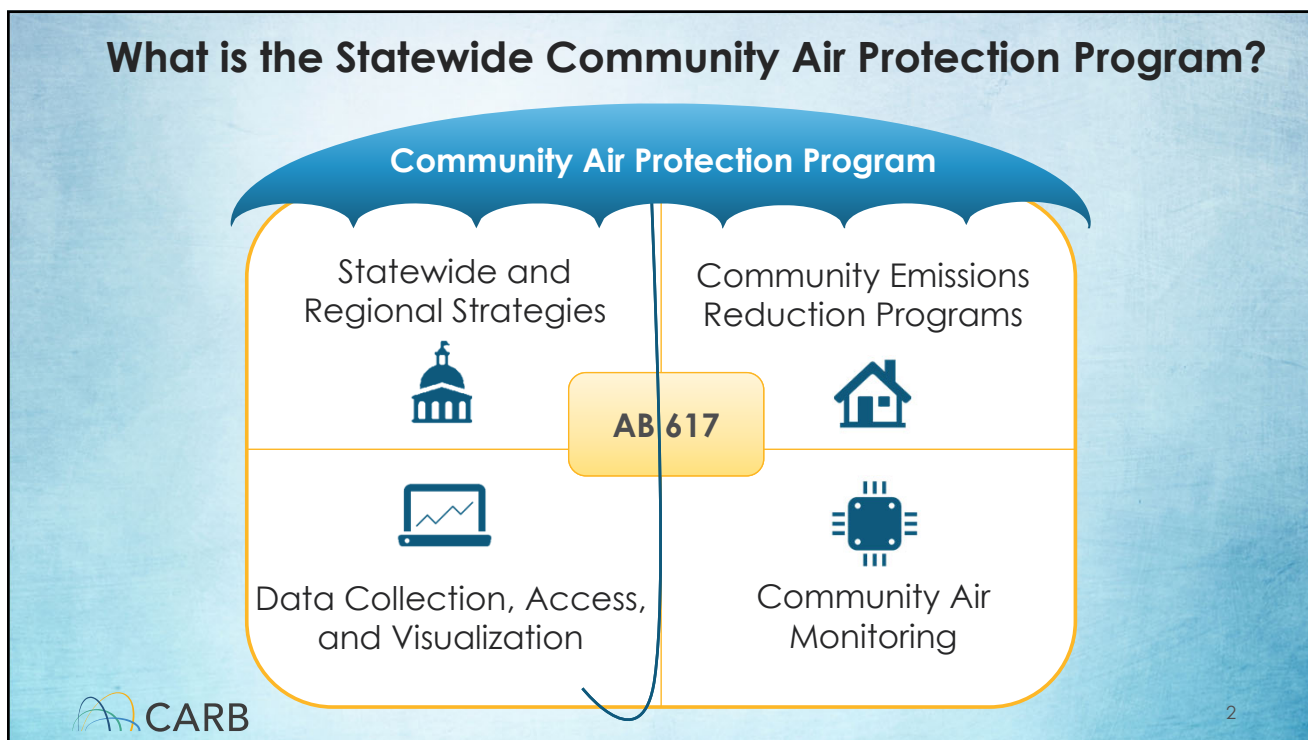

Stockton Community Emissions Reduction Program Development

Community Steering Committee (CSC)

- Charter Establishes:
 - Goals, Roles and Responsibilities
 - Membership Process
- 40 Members (as of June 1, 2021)
- 18 CSC Meetings (March 2020 – March 2021)
 - Plus, Informational Meetings from District and CARB



CSC unanimously approved CERP – March 3, 2021
San Joaquin Valley APCD Board adopted CERP – March 18, 2021
CARB Board Considers CERP – July 29, 2021



Stockton CERP Overview

- includes wide variety of clean air measures designed through cooperative community-driven process
 - received unanimous support from CSC
- includes investment of \$32 million in clean air projects
 - Expected to reduce 698 tons NO_x, 66 tons PM_{2.5}, & 53 tons VOC

CERP Strategies

- Incentive-based Strategies
 - New/enhanced opportunities to promote clean air technologies
- Exposure Reduction Strategies (air filtration at schools, vegetative barriers, etc.)

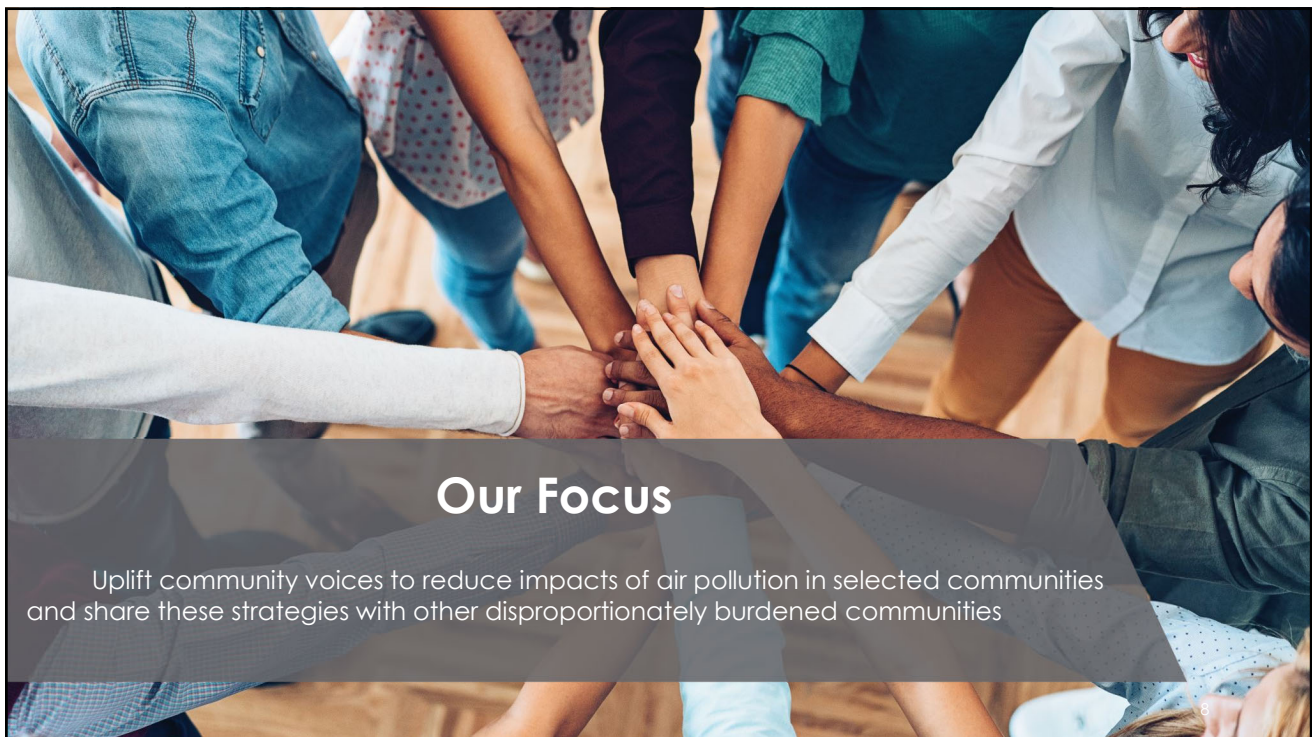


CERP Strategies, Cont'd

- Outreach & Engagement Strategies to improve air quality understanding
- Partnerships with Other Agencies (CARB, Cities, Counties, CalTrans, SJCOG, etc.)
- Regulatory Strategies
 - Requires public process, extensive existing stationary and mobile source regulations
- Enforcement Strategies
 - Focused enforcement efforts of local and state regulations

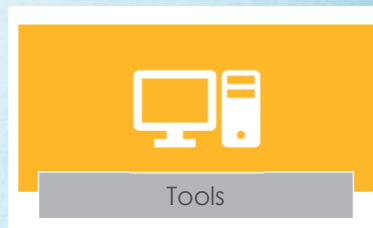
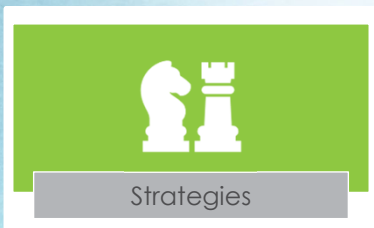

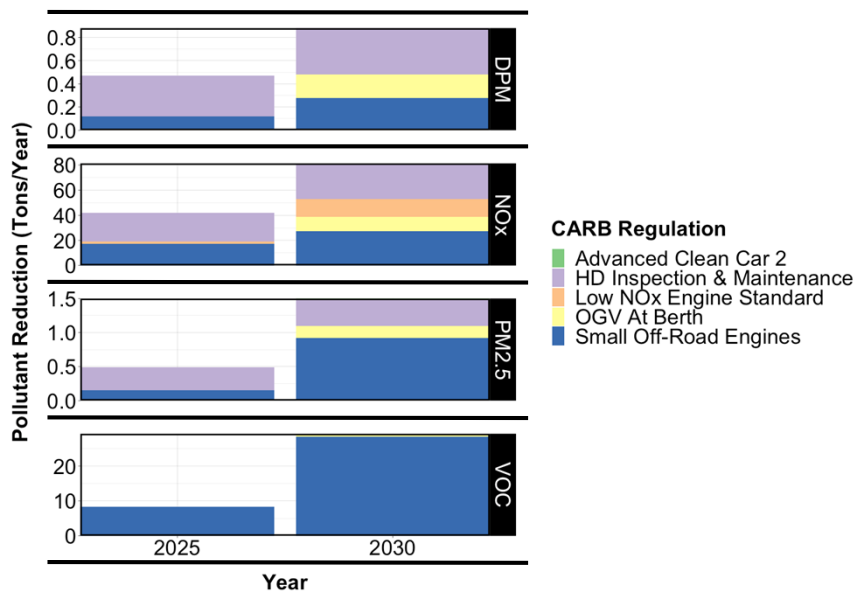
CARB Statewide Mandates in AB 617

Preliminary Draft Estimated Benefits from Statewide Strategies to Stockton


