In developing a scoping plan, there are many points of direction and coordination. The list below provides a sense of the governing requirements and guidance we must follow. The list is not exhaustive and we focus on a few key statutes like AB 32 and AB 197, as well as statutes that cover topics like short-lived climate pollutants, community air protection, forestry, or others that can provide valuable input into the Scoping Plan. There are also a number of executive orders we must consider. These go back to before AB 32 was signed, up to the recent ones issued last year by Governor Newsom.
