2022 Scoping Plan Update Revised DRAFT Overall Schedule and Dates for Deliverables

CARB is tasked with developing the update to the Scoping Plan to reflect progress towards the SB 32 2030 GHG target and to map the path to carbon neutrality no later than 2045. In addition, as part of the Scoping Plan process, the Governor has instructed CARB to evaluate phase-out of oil extraction by 2045 and provided more recent direction in a letter to CARB's Chair to evaluate how to achieve carbon neutrality by 2035.

The process to update the Scoping Plan officially started upon reconvening of the Environmental Justice Advisory Committee (EJ Advisory Committee or EJAC) on May 20, 2021. This was followed by a kick-off workshop series June 8-10, 2021. There have been additional technical workshops on Natural & Working Lands and Engineered Carbon Removal on July 20, 2021 and August 2, 2021, respectively. In addition, a Short-Lived Climate Pollutant workshop was held on September 8, 2021 and a Scenario Concepts Technical workshops held on August 17, 2021. In addition, CARB moved the deadline for scenario assumptions input from EJAC from early September to late November.

The schedule below commences from August 3, 2021. All dates are tentative and subject to change. This document represents the best information available at the time it was drafted.
