On February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022, **CARB's Executive Officer** appointed Jill Sherman-Warne, **Executive** Director of the Native American Environmental **Protection Coalition (NAEPC)** and enrolled member of the Hoopa Tribe as the EJAC's inaugural Tribal member.

# **EJAC Community Engagement cont.**

CARB process for EJAC Community Engagement proposals:

- 1. Submit proposals to Ambreen Afshan at least 3 weeks in advance
- 2. Ambreen will confirm receipt and work directly with EJAC members on the proposal
- 3. Once proposals are finalized, CARB will process proposals and develop contracts with each organization conducting community engagement
- 4. Once proposals are finalized, CARB will process proposals and develop contracts with each organization conducting community engagement. Key information needed to process the contracts:
  - a) Contract Amount per Organization
  - b) Project Manager Name and Contact Information
  - c) Signatory Name and Contact Information
