EJAC Comments

Natural and Working Lands

"CARB should" is implied at the start of every comment listed in the table below.

Collaborate with Native Nations
Respond to how co-benefits incorporate into the larger picture.
Respond to how dairy digesters can be included in modeling without knowing all of the impacts, especially co-pollutants & methane.
Look at offshore.
Work with water resources.
Look for roads & energy infrastructure data.
Seek to improve the modeling for the 2022 Scoping Plan Update and not already give up until 2027.
Include pesticide emissions.
Respond to the limitation on including emissions from fumigants that release nitrogen dioxide. One is produced in CA, energy intensive & used in CA.
Adopt organic farming in Scoping Plan scenario.
Share the improvements that the previous EJAC asked for. From the 2008 EJAC Recommendations: "Recommendation to Protect Farmland: The Committee recommends that ARB encourage land use planning and development that protects farmland. ARB should also encourage organic and other sustainable farming practices that reduce greenhouse gas emissions from fertilizers and pesticides."
Not ignore 100% of 2017 EJAC Recommendations.
Respond to how environmental justice communities support the creation & development of more natural land development.
Include a negative carbon subregion as a goal.
Seek nontraditional technical input.
