Overview

- In 2021, the Board approved Small Off-Road Engine (SORE) regulation amendment which requires manufacturers to produce zero-emission (ZE) equipment.
 - 2024 for most SORE-powered equipment.
 - 2028 for generators.
- To further support the transition to ZE, Moyer State Reserve fiscal year 21-22 \$24.7M will be dedicated to lawn and garden equipment.



Moyer Lawn and Garden Program Background

- The Carl Moyer Program has funded the replacement of SORE-powered equipment since 2011.
- Current program funds residential ZE lawn mowers only.
- Current funding level is \$145.



Proposed Chapter Updates

Applicant Eligibility

- Propose expanding the focus of this chapter beyond residential lawn and garden needs.
- Requires separate eligibility requirements
 - Residential California residence
 - Commercial
 - Own and operate equipment in California, and
 - Business license, employer identification number, personal or business tax identification number



Equipment Eligibility

- All horsepower combustion lawn and garden equipment eligible for replacement.
- Replacements must serve the same purpose and be new, cordless, and ZE electric lawn and garden equipment.
- Eligible categories include the following:
 - Chainsaws, trimmers, edgers, brushcutters
 - Leaf blowers and vacuums
 - Walk behind mowers
 - Ride-on or stand/sit mowers



Maximum Funding Amounts

Equipment	Residential Grant Amount	Commercial Grant Amount
Chainsaws/trimmers/ edgers/brushcutters	\$300	\$700
Leaf blowers/vacuums	\$200	\$1,400
Walk behind mowers	\$330	\$1,500
Ride-on or stand/sit Mowers	\$2,000	\$15,000

Eligible purchases = Lawn and garden equipment + batteries and chargers up to max. Cannot exceed total costs of items purchased.

Co-Funding

- Supports the SORE regulation in the transition to ZE lawn and garden equipment, as seamless as possible with streamlined administrative requirements.
- Opportunities for increased funding for small business when co-funding.
