

### **5<sup>th</sup> Annual Community Recommendations**












Community Air Protection BLUEPRINT




# **Blueprint 2.0 Engagement Objectives**

- Focus on Community, Racial Equity, and Environmental Justice
- People's Blueprint Influence
- Collaborative, as opposed to a decide, announce and defend model
- Meaningful dialogue with interested parties

- Focused outreach to communities nominated but not selected for the AB 617 Program
- Understand the perspectives and concerns of
  - AB 617 communities
  - Communities highly impacted by air pollution.
