This timeline is **subject to change at CARB's discretion.** Note: For proposed regulations to be considered by the Board, many of them are already in the rulemaking process with a Notice and Initial Statement of Reasons issued to start the 45-day public comment period.

For reference, the formal regulatory activity always begins with the release of the 45-Day Hearing Notice and the Staff Report / Initial Statement of Reasons for the Proposed Rulemaking, and later can include the 15-Day Notice, the documents forwarded to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for formal approval, and acknowledgement of the OAL's action on the rulemaking.

The EJAC's ability to have its input included may be limited due to the stage of the rulemaking. This table shows the quarter where the proposed regulations and other implementation activities will mostly likely be heard by the Board.
