



## Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Low Carbon Investments Grant Solicitation for Statewide Clean Cars 4 All and Financing Assistance Projects

## List of Applications Received May 2, 2023

**Project Summary:** The California Air Resources Board (CARB or the Board) completed a joint solicitation for a Grantee to implement and administer the Statewide Clean Cars 4 All and Financing Assistance projects for Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-23 with an option to renew for a new Grant Agreement for each of the following two years for FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25. On November 17, 2022, the Board approved \$125 million for Statewide Clean Cars 4 All, \$66 million for Financing Assistance, and \$10 million to support the Zero-Emission Assurance Project (ZAP) to encourage the adoption of clean technology vehicles for low-income Californians.

The joint solicitation was open for applications from February 22, 2023, through March 24, 2023.
