The District used G20 funds to continue the Wood Smoke Reduction Program (WSRP) in 2022. Most Grantees were locted in primarily low-income and/or in disadvantaged communities of Eastern Kern.

III. How is grant being utilized to meet goals of AB 617: (If applicable, include emissions reductions being achieved)

Most of the projects were located in the District's PM10 NAAQS Nonattainment area, which is also considered low income.

IV. Summary of work completed and in progress since the last progress report:

Approximately 22 old high emitting residentail wood stoves used as a primary heat source were replaced with new low emitting efficient natural gas, propane, or pellet soves.

V. Grant funds remaining and expended:

The G20 grant award was \$60,403. All G20 funds were allocated to WSRP project. There are no remaining G20 funds.

VI. Expenditure summary showing all Community Air Protection Program Implementation Funds for which reimbursement is being requested:

All G20 funds have been received and liquidated. All G20 funds were awarded to individual residents of Eastern Kern County for WSRP projects. None of the G20 funds were used by the District for program administration or any other costs associated with implementing the WSRP. No CAP funds are being requested at this time.
