Staff documented 157 hours from 6/28/20 to 6/26/21. 157 hrs at \$108/hr is \$16,956.00 The FY 19/20 grant was for \$25,787.00. The remaining \$8,831 plus interest was expended on staff time choosing locations and deploying purple air monitors in the region during May and June of 2022.
