Introduction

- Advanced Clean Fleets (ACF) Regulation
 - Adopted by Board on April 28, 2023
 - To be finalized by Office of Administrative Law
- Committed to successful implementation
- The truck regulatory advisory committee (TRAC) concept used before
 - Stakeholder advisory group
 - To facilitate communication with stakeholders to improve regulation implementation



Advisory Committee Purpose

- Discuss best practices for ACF implementation consistent with the regulation language
- Develop recommendations and action items on selected topics
- Facilitate constructive dialogue to address key rule implementation issues



Advisory Committee Meetings Concept

- Facilitate open "round table" discussion to improve productivity
 - Identify committee members with active role
 - Meetings recorded and everyone can listen
- Quarterly meetings on key topic areas
 - Meet more frequently on an as needed basis

Outreach Committee

- Build on experiences from prior fleet rules
- Outreach methods to inform affected fleets
 - Best ways to outreach to fleets
 - What information do they need
 - Equity consideration
 - Leveraging grassroots efforts
- Review materials, messaging and reporting tools



Border Communities Committee

- Work with border fleets on solutions to challenges
- Explore coordination opportunities
 - Fleet operators in Mexico
 - Border communities
 - Infrastructure solutions



Infrastructure Committee

- Work with fleets to overcome challenges in deploying infrastructure
- Best methods to help fleets engage early and often with electricity and hydrogen providers
- Review available tools to assist with installing infrastructure
- Opportunities for fleets to engage in the multi-agency planning efforts
 - Grid reliability/resilience
 - Communication with utilities
 - Use of available planning tools



Rule Provisions Committee

- Smooth process for implementing rule provisions
 - Work through details and issues
- Prioritize key provisions application process
 - Zero-emission vehicle (ZEV) Purchase Exemption process
 - Infrastructure delay extension process
 - Other

 - Concurrent subcommittee "break-out" rooms
 - Committee meeting after
 - Subcommittees report in
- All active members are panelists (live microphone)
- All others listen and view online
- Meetings recorded



Option 3: Virtual Meetings – Different Days

- Subcommittee meetings on different days each quarter
 - Meet during same week
 - No concurrent meetings
 - Need for full committee?
- All active members are panelists (live microphone)
- All others listen and view online
- Meetings recorded



Member Selection and Expectations



Active Member Expectations

- Attend and participate in quarterly meetings
 - Additional meetings as needed
- Review meeting summaries for accuracy and completeness
- Collaborate and discuss proposed solutions



Active Member Selection Criteria

- Diverse representation
 - Regulated entities and directly affected stakeholders
 - Fleet owners, industry organizations, trade groups, manufacturers, subject matter experts, etc.
- Maximize productivity by limiting number of active members?



Active Member Application


- Name, occupation and affiliation
- Identify subcommittee of preference and a second or choice
 - Brief statement of qualifications and why you are a good fit
- Whether you are interested in being a chairperson


