Project Summary: On November 19, 2021, the California Air Resources Board (CARB) approved a \$1.5 million allocation toward Workforce Training and Development projects in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22 Funding Plan for Clean Transportation Incentives. On August 25, 2023, CARB released a solicitation for Grantee(s) to implement the Adult Education & Vocational School Zero-Emission Vehicle (ZEV) Technology Training Project for FY2021-22 to develop new or strengthen existing workforce training and development programs and training curriculum for ZEV technologies.

The solicitation was open for applications August 25, 2023, through October 27, 2023. CARB received three applications that are listed below in alphabetical order.
