

SUBJECT:

Check for the Air Pollution Control Fund from UP Railroad Company (UP)

A check from "UP Railroad Company" (a subsidiary of Union Pacific Corporation) is enclosed for deposit into the Air Pollution Control Fund. This check (Number 1404634), in the amount of twelve hundred dollars (\$1200.00), is for settlement of violations of the ARB/Railroad Statewide Agreement ("Agreement"). Specifically, these funds are for settlement of Notice of Violation #RR10-2029, RR10-2034 and RR10-1060 that were issued to UP on March 23, April 28, and May 11, 2011, respectively.

The Agreement specifies that penalties shall be credited towards Carl Moyer Program activities in the air district where the violations occurred. Therefore, these funds shall be credited for Carl Moyer Program activities in the South Coast Air Quality Management District, Mojave Desert Air Quality Management District, and Placer County Air Pollution Control District.
