What is TRUCRS?

Truck Regulation Upload, Compliance and Reporting System (TRUCRS)

- Online reporting system.
- Owners of affected vehicles can report and update company, vehicle, and engine information to meet fleet reporting requirements, and
- Print a certificate of reported compliance.

What regulations are included in TRUCRS?

- Truck and Bus,
- Solid Waste Collection Vehicle, and
- Zero-Emissions Airport Shuttle Regulations,
- Advanced Clean Fleets.
- NOT Clean Truck Check (CTC) program
 - CTC reporting is done through a separate reporting portal on the CTC reporting webpage (<https://ww2.arb.ca.gov/our-work/programs/inspection-and-maintenance-program/reporting-database>).

Reporting Deadlines

Truck and Bus, Solid Waste Collection Vehicle, Zero-emissions
Airport Shuttle Bus

- January 31, 2024

Advanced Clean Fleets

- Drayage Trucks - December 31, 2023
- High Priority Fleets - February 1, 2024
- State and Local Government Fleets - April 1, 2024

Enforcement Notice

- On December 28, 2023, CARB issued an enforcement notice for ACF
 - CARB will not take enforcement action on the drayage or high priority fleet reporting requirements or registration prohibitions until U.S. EPA grants a preemption waiver or determines a waiver is not necessary
 - CARB encourages fleets to voluntarily report and comply while the waiver request is pending and reserves all of its rights to enforce the ACF regulation in full for any period for which a waiver is granted or determined to be unnecessary
 - CARB will accept requests for the extensions and exemptions available under the ACF regulation during this period
- Once the waiver is granted or determined to be unnecessary, fleets may need to remove any vehicle from the California fleet that was not eligible to be added after January 1, 2024

Enforcement Discretion Notice in TRUCRS

ssl.arb.ca.gov says

The Advanced Clean Fleets Regulation (Regulation) - Drayage truck requirements deadline to report combustion-powered vehicles for drayage truck operation was December 31, 2023. Any combustion-powered vehicles added to the reporting system that were not previously reported by December 31, 2023, may be restricted from performing drayage services once the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency grants California a waiver for the Regulation pursuant to section 209 of the federal Clean Air Act or determines that no such waiver is necessary.

OK

- Any combustion-powered vehicles added into service in California in high priority or federal fleets after December 31, 2023, may be restricted from operating once the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency grants California a waiver for the Regulation pursuant to section 209 of the federal Clean Air Act or determines no such waiver is necessary. Once the waiver is granted or determined to be unnecessary, fleets may need to remove any vehicle from the California fleet that was not eligible to be added to the California fleet after January 1, 2024, or the fleet must elect to comply with the Zero-Emission Vehicle (ZEV) Milestone Option instead of the Model Year Schedule.

Ready to report for Clean Truck Check?

The California Air Resources Board (CARB) is extending the Clean Truck Check reporting deadline to January 31, 2024, to allow vehicle owners additional time to complete their initial fleet reporting and meet the compliance fee requirement for 2023.

Reporting is also open for the Advanced Clean Fleets (ACF) Regulation.

High Priority Fleets, state and local governments, and drayage truck fleet owners subject to ACF regulatory requirements must report annually.

I reported in TRUCRS in previous years, what's changed?

- Updates have been made in TRUCRS to update reporting for the ACF regulation.
- You will need to provide information that you may not have previously reported.
- Company and the vehicle tabs have been updated.
- Certificate of reported compliance updated to include all regulations to which a fleet is subject.
- Previously reported information is still in your TRUCRS account.
- Will need to review the company and vehicle tabs and update information.

Welcome to TRUCRS!

TRUCRS has been updated and fleets can now input company and vehicle information for their Advanced Clean Fleets reporting. Compliance calculations, exemptions, and certificates will not be available until 2024. To report for the Clean Truck Check program, please visit the California Clean Truck Check, Vehicle Inspection System at: <https://cleantruckcheck.arb.ca.gov/>

If you are reporting a 2010 engine or newer for the Truck and Bus Regulation please select "PM Filter - Original Equipment" as compliance option. If you are reporting a non-diesel powered vehicle, please select "None" as compliance option.

The [TRUCRS User Guide](#) is updated annually and will help you use the TRUCRS database to comply with the Truck and Bus, Solid Waste Collection Vehicle (SWCV), and Zero Emission Airport Shuttle (ZEAS) regulations.

To comply with the reporting requirement of the Zero Emission Airport Shuttle regulation, please see the [Airport Shuttle TRUCRS User Guide](#).

The annual reporting period for vehicles subject to ZEAS is January 1st to March 1st of each compliance year.

For the Truck and Bus Regulation, if you are experiencing delays in delivery of compliant vehicles or replacement engines purchased prior to September 1st, please review the Manufacturer delay Fact Sheet available [here](#).

It is the responsibility of the fleet to keep and make available upon request all necessary reporting records for the appropriate number of years as required per each regulation.

Senate Bill 1 (SB1) requires the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to deny registration for any vehicles not compliant with the Truck and Bus regulation.

Large fleets attempting to upload vehicle data into TRUCRS can use the CARB Large Fleet Upload spreadsheet [Click to Download](#). To ensure proper functionality, the spreadsheet needs to be downloaded, saved, and run on your local computer. The spreadsheet is Microsoft Excel based and may not function properly if opened using a browser or through any non-Microsoft Excel program. Furthermore, the use of macros is required to create the upload file.

When the spreadsheet is first open, depending on your system settings, it may show 'Enable Editing' in a yellow bar on the top of the screen, if it does then you must select it to use the spreadsheet. After enabling editing, you will see an 'Enable Content' warning on a yellow bar just below the menu icons, you must select this to activate the macros to create an upload file once the spreadsheet is completed.

The spreadsheet contains various formulas to validate information entered. The status of the entries will be displayed in the "Information Status" column (last data column on the right), and only the rows with the status of "OK for upload" will be included in the upload file. Rows with indicated errors must be corrected before they will be included in the upload file. Once the spreadsheet is completed and the macros are enabled, click the "Create Upload File" button, this will activate the macros and generate a file with the following name pattern: trucrs_ID_XXXXX_vehicle_update.prn . Once you have the completed upload file, navigate back to this page to upload. Please note that this version will mass insert the new vehicles or mass update (replace) existing vehicle information. It does not have the functionality to perform mass deletion. If you need assistance or have questions, please call our Hotline at (866) 634-3735.

Applying for ACF Exemptions

- Must be requested via email through TRUCRS@arb.ca.gov.
- Cannot apply for any ACF exemption from your TRUCRS account.
- Email must include TRUCRS ID number, and all documentation required for the specific exemption being requested.
- If request is approved, CARB staff will send an email notifying you the extension was approved and will update your TRUCRS account to reflect the approved exemption.
- For ACF exemption information, visit the ACF fact sheets page, "Extensions and Exemptions" section.

Applying for the ACF 5-day pass

- 5-day pass grants a fleet a temporary pass that will allow a vehicle not compliant with ACF entry in California for 5-days.
- To apply, login to your TRUCRS account,
- From the "Vehicle Info" tab, under the "Flexibility Options" section you can select "5-Day Pass" from the drop-down menu.
- Enter the "Date of First Use", year-month-day, that the vehicle will be entering California.
- Each vehicle in the fleet can only use one 5-day pass per calendar year.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Where do I find the engine family or engine model year?
2. Do I need to enter a vehicle family name when reporting a zero-emission vehicle?
3. Is it necessary to input an engine family name when reporting my vehicles?
4. Do I stay in the Low-Use Exemption, or do I update to the Backup Exemption? Can you explain the differences?
5. My vehicle has a short vin, why isn't TRUCRS not accepting?
6. Why is my TRUCRS account showing not compliant with Truck and Bus, but all reported diesel vehicles over 14,000 lbs. GVWR have 2010 or newer engines?
