Dear Mr. Lovenburg,

The California Air Resources Board (CARB) received BNSF Railway's (BNSF) 2023 Fleet Average Agreement Annual Compliance Report (Compliance Report) pursuant to Section IV.B. of the 1998 Memorandum of Mutual Understanding and Agreements, South Coast Locomotive Fleet Average Emissions Program (1998 MOU). CARB staff determined that in 2023 BNSF complied with provisions of the 1998 MOU which requires the final annual locomotive fleet average be under 5.5 grams per brake horsepower-hour (g/bhp-hr) for oxides of nitrogen (NOx) for locomotive operations in the South Coast Air Basin, to meet the final fleet average standard.

Compliance Evaluation: Calendar Year 2023

BNSF's Compliance Report included the following:

- 1. Signed letter of certification verifying the information in the report is true, accurate, and complete.
- 2. Fleet summary information regarding the methodology used to comply with the 1998 MOU (Form F-S).
- 3. Fleet average calculation showing the individual locomotive megawatt-hours (MWh) and emissions levels, as well as calculations and any necessary adjustments (Form F-A-1 through F-A-6).

BNSF's 2023 Compliance Report submittal included activity information (in MWh) and emissions levels for over 5,000 locomotives. CARB staff determined that for calendar year 2023, BNSF's final fleet average of 5.1 g/bhp-hr meets the NOx compliance level set forth in the 1998 MOU.

CARB will make the BNSF Compliance Report information publicly available except for individual locomotive activity levels, which are business confidential according to California Government Code Section 6254.7. The activity data will be aggregated by tier and emission level.
