Dear Timothy Hayes,

Thank you for submitting the revised Terminal Plan (Plan) on behalf of Tesoro Logistics Operations LLC for the Terminal 1, Terminal 2, and Long Beach Terminal to the California Air Resources Board (CARB) as required by the Control Measure for Ocean-Going Vessels At Berth ("Regulation"). Updated Plans for Southern California tanker terminals were due to CARB by February 1, 2024. Tesoro submitted their updated Plan on January 31, 2024. However, on April 29, 2024, CARB notified Tesoro that their submission was incomplete because it lacked the feasibility study referenced in the Plan. In response, Tesoro provided the missing feasibility study and updated Plan to CARB on May 24, 2024. CARB staff have reviewed your revised Plan submittals and have determined that these Plans fulfill the requirements of the Regulation as set forth in sections 93130.14(a). CARB considers these Plans complete, and no changes are necessary at this time.

If any significant changes occur to any elements of your Plan(s), you may resubmit an updated Plan to CARB (shorepower@arb.ca.gov) at any time.
